


Printing from personal devices & macOS:

1. Visit the following page: <https://unis.eu.uniflowonline.com/> and sign in with your UNIS account.
2. Choose "Start printing" from the left menu.
3. Under "install printer driver," pick your OS version and download the driver.
4. Click on "Dashboard" in the left menu.
5. In the "Identities section", you'll find a PIN code for linking your account to your UNIS card. Proceed to a printer, tap your card onto the card reader, and when it beeps, enter the PIN code.
6. **You now have to select "secure printing" when initiating the print job.**


When you log into your computer after the software has been installed you will see the window below.

Enter your uniFLOW Online Account name (in email address format) that was provided in your **Welcome to uniFLOW Online** email and enable **Remember my choice of identity provider** then click **Continue**.
